Florida’s Blackwater River and Tate’s Hell State Forests, covering 413,000 acres, became certified to the SFI Forest Management Standard thanks in part to support from the SFI Forest Partners Program, which links communities and forest managers to responsible purchasers.

Public and privately owned forests have a positive impact on the environment as well as the economy of Florida. Strong markets for forest products support jobs and emerging markets for new products creates opportunities both domestically and abroad, including opportunities to enhance Florida’s global competitiveness through certification of its forests and forest products. That’s why the Sustainable Forestry Initiative has initiated a project in Florida to make it easier for forest products companies and landowners in Florida to certify to the SFI Standards and gear up for marketplace shifts toward the sourcing of more certified products. With the support of SFI’s Forest Partners making the certification process easier and more cost effective, the time has never been better to certify to the SFI Standards.
